

MEDIA ALERT/PHOTO OP: VAN HORN LAW GROUP VOLUNTEERS TO DELIVER FOOD TO 100+ BROWARD FAMILIES

WHO/ WHAT: Approximately 25 volunteers from Van Horn Law Group, P.A., will deliver boxes of food to more than 100 Broward County families who have been adversely affected due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The families reached out in response a Van Horn Law Group social media post offering food assistance to those in need.

Founding attorney Chad Van Horn worked with executives at The Tower Club to order and purchase more than 200 rolls of toilet paper and paper towels, 200 pounds each of chicken breast, ground chuck, rice and pasta, 200 dozen eggs and 100 boxes of fresh produce. The Tower Club staff, led by General Manager David DiRenzo and Event Director Alena Worley, will prepare more than 100 food boxes for delivery.

To maintain social distancing, volunteers will line up in their cars at the east entrance of the Regions Bank building. Tower Club staff will place the food boxes in each car. Volunteers will immediately take them to families who've requested them.

"So many of our neighbors are now facing food insecurity because of a loss of income, a fear of shopping, or becoming sick. They've landed in place where they never thought they'd be even two months ago," said Van Horn. "I just want to help alleviate the suffering of as many people in our community as possible. I'm so proud of my team who has volunteered to help, and grateful to the Tower Club leadership for their assistance in securing these much-needed groceries."

Less than two months ago, Van Horn and his new wife Gabriela hosted their wedding reception at the Tower Club and established a strong relationship with Club executives. At that time, a worldwide pandemic and an economic shutdown didn't even cross their mind. That relationship now has been instrumental in helping more than 100 families in need.

Van Horn and his team are in the process of launching two additional initiatives: a partnership with Heart2Heart Outreach to grocery shop for the elderly as well as a program to pay water bills for Fort Lauderdale residents who are behind on their payments. Van Horn is laser focused on helping with the basics, doing his best to ensure as many people as possible have food and water.
