**Van Horn Law Group
Makes *Inc.*'s 2020 List of 5,000 Fastest-growing Companies,
Second Year in a Row**

Inc. magazine ranked Van Horn Law Group, P.A. on its 2020 list of the top 5,000 fastest-growing, privately held companies in the United States. With growth of 76 percent since 2016 and revenues of \$2.9 million last year, the company landed in position 4,321 of businesses nationwide, according to an *Inc.* announcement today. Van Horn Law Group also ranked on the *Inc.* 5000 list last year, coming in at 4,695 and growth at 61 percent.

Inc.'s 2020 annual ranking of America's top 5,000 businesses represents 49 states, Puerto Rico, and the District of Columbia, with aggregate revenue of \$209 billion in 2019, accounting for more than one million jobs over the past three years. Companies were ranked according to percentage revenue growth from 2016 to 2019. To qualify, companies must have been founded and generating revenue by March 31, 2016. They must be U.S.-based, privately held, for-profit, and independent as of December 31, 2019. The minimum revenue required for 2015 is \$100,000; the minimum for 2018 is \$2 million. Even in this era of COVID-19, Van Horn has continued to be a trailblazer. The firm recently confirmed the first Chapter 11 Subchapter V Business Bankruptcy (Case No. 20-12446-EPK) in the state of Florida. Subchapter V of the [Small Business Reorganization Act](#), which passed last summer and became effective in February, streamlines the Bankruptcy Code's Chapter 11 process. It gives businesses more time to negotiate with creditors, reduce monthly payments and decrease the total amount owed to creditors, of particular importance in today's economic environment.

Van Horn and his team are committed to helping small businesses and individuals make it through the pandemic by providing first-rate, affordable legal services with compassion, understanding and respect. Speedy utilization of this new Subchapter V tool illustrates the firm's expertise as well as its commitment to its clients.
